**RESOLUTION 07-10-17A**

**RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT TO PACE ENGINEERS, INC. FOR THE DESIGN OF  
PROJECT SW07-1 THUNDERBIRD DRIVE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT**

**Whereas**, District crews responded on the evening of Wednesday, October 3, 2007 to a water main break at 23034 Thunderbird Drive, in the City of Des Moines. A four foot section of ductile iron with couplings was installed to replace the existing 6" A.C. main. Due to the condition of the A.C. main, District management is concerned that there is a potential for future main breaks in the area and would like to mitigate the possibility by replacing approximately 1,300 lineal feet of A.C. water main.

**Whereas**, the existing mains included in the project are more than 50 years old and have met or exceeded their expected design life. They existing mains will be replaced with state-of-the-art materials and installed with current construction techniques.

**Whereas**, per the District's request, PACE Engineers, Inc. submitted a scope of work for the design of this project. The District's resident engineer and General Manager have reviewed the scope of work and recommend approval of this resolution.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

1. The General Manager or designee is authorized to enter into a contract with PACE Engineers, Inc. for a not-to-exceed price of \$40,000 for the design of Project SW07-1 Thunderbird Drive Water Main Replacement.




