HIGHLINE COMMUNITY COLLEGE FIRE LANE EXTENSION
HIGHLINE WATER DISTRICT WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT

Whereas, this project consisted of abandoning a portion of Highline Water District main located on Highline Community College real property and the installation of approximately 1,000 LF of 12" ductile iron main, fire hydrants and associated appurtenances.

Whereas, by passage of Resolution 05-9-7A the Board authorized Project SW06-2.

Whereas, Highline Community College was the lead agency for this project


The work for Highline Water District has been completed per District standards, and the District Engineer recommends final acceptance. The General Manager concurs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:


1. The Board of Commissioners accepts as complete Project SW06-2 Highline Community College Fire Lane Extension and Highline Water District Water Main Replacement.
2. The General Manager is authorized to sign the paperwork necessary to close out this project.




