**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BID FOR
PROJECT 05-4 MILITARY RD. S. WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT
WITH THE CITY OF SEATAC AS LEAD AGENCY**

WHEREAS, the scope of work includes the installation of 4,790 lineal feet of 4, 6, 8, and 12-inch ductile iron waterline, 33 water valves sizes 4, 6, 8, 12, and 18-inch, 10 fire hydrants, trenching, traffic control, survey, surface restoration, and all necessary appurtenances.

WHEREAS, the City of Seatac and the Highline Water District desire to work together for the mutual and overall benefit of the roadway project and the water facility relocation work.

WHEREAS, by passage of Resolution 06-8-2A, Highline Water District entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Seatac (Lead Agency) for the Military Road South Project 05-4.

WHEREAS, Highline Water District management staff have reviewed the bids for their portion of the work and recommend accepting the low bid submitted by Tucci & Sons in an amount not-to-exceed \$782,832.01 (includes sales tax).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

The General Manager or designee is authorized to accept the bid by Tucci & Sons for Project 05-4 Military Rd. S. Water Main Replacement.


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
