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#### 5. RESOLUTIONS AND MOTIONS

<u>Resolution 25-3-19A:</u> Resolution authorizing an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Des Moines for Project 24-6 S 240<sup>th</sup> St Water Main Relocation Project. Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried 4-0.

Motion 25-3-19(1): Motion authorizing application for DWSRF Consolidation Feasibility Study Grant on Behalf of KCWD 54. Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried 4-0.

# 6. STAFF/COMMISSIONERS/ATTORNEY Jeremy DelMar

- 6.1 <u>KCWD54 Update</u>: General Manager Jeremy DelMar gave an update of recent events regarding KCWD 54 and their letter requesting Highline apply for a DWSRF Consolidation Grant. Grant amounts are up to \$50,000 to explore feasibility for water agencies to consolidate their operations. DOH, the awarding agency, will require HWD to apply for the grant on behalf of WD54. WD54 has authorized up to \$2,500 to reimburse the District expenses to apply for the grant and up to \$25,000 to begin the feasibility in advance of grant selection. Discussion ensued. The Board authorized staff to apply for the grant on behalf of WD54 [See **Motion 25-3-19(1)**].
- 6.2 <u>District Headquarters Break-in</u>: DelMar informed the Board of a recent break-in at the District headquarters occurring over the March 15<sup>th</sup> weekend. The perpetrators stole small diameter brass and copper fittings from the parts warehouse. Staff are working with the police on the investigation and will notify the State Auditor Office of the losses once they are inventoried. The total amount of the loss is not yet known.
- 6.2 <u>Vehicle Purchases</u>: DelMar mentioned the District is in the process of ordering vehicles through the cooperative purchasing programs that were identified in the annual budget. He sought feedback from the Board on the purchase of a Tesla EV as there are several incentives that make the vehicles more economical than other alternatives in the past. Discussion ensued. The Board members provided their individual feedback but left the final decision to the General Manager.
