Our mission is to provide high quality water and excellent customer service while effectively managing District infrastructure for a reliable water system today and for future generations.

Highline Water District serves potable water to approximately 110,000 people living and working in South King Countyincluding portions of the cities of Burien, Des Moines, Federal Way, Kent, Normandy Park, SeaTac, and Tukwila, as well as areas in unincorporated King County. The District encompasses roughly 18 square miles and provides water to our customers through approximately 18,900 water meters. Seventy-five percent (75%) of our water is supplied by Seattle Public Utilities, with the remaining portion produced from three District-owned groundwater wells with two treatment facilities. The District employs 34 dedicated professionals and is governed by a five-member Board of Commissioners who are elected by the customers we serve. Our 2025 Operating Budget is \$31 million dollars and includes approximately \$9 million in capital improvements.

About the Position

The District is currently seeking a Temporary Seasonal Maintenance Worker. As a Maintenance Worker, you will join the Operations Department and report to the Operations and Field Supervisors. This is a temporary position lasting no more than 100 calendar days from May through August.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

As a successful candidate, you will be responsible for performing maintenance on fire hydrants, painting, office maintenance, grounds maintenance, vehicle maintenance, courier duties, and other duties as assigned. This position is considered an entry-level position, and an ideal candidate will have knowledge or experience in cleaning, operating grounds equipment (weed eater, pressure washer, etc.), working outdoors, and experience using hand and power tools.

Requirements

Applicants must be 18 years of age or older, possess a Valid Washington State Driver's License, have a high school diploma or GED. See Job Description for a listing of duties and requirements.
