RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AS COMPLETE PROJECT 18-5 34th AVENUE SOUTH WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT

WHEREAS, upon notice from the City of SeaTac that its proposed roadway improvements along 34th Avenue South (South 160th Street to South 166th Street) conflicted with the District's existing water main requiring relocation of the water main to accommodate the City's project, the Board of Commissioners authorized a design contract with Parametrix, Inc. on October 23, 2018, and executed an Interlocal Agreement with the City on August 4, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised and awarded the project to R.L. Alia Company; and

WHEREAS, the District installed approximately 2,500 LF of 12-inch and smaller diameter DI water main along with new services, fittings, valves, hydrants and other water main appurtenances in accordance with the Interlocal Agreement between the District and the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of SeaTac's contractor, R.L. Alia Company, completed the water work construction per District standards and the District Engineer recommends final acceptance. The General Manager concurs.
