6.1 <u>Tyee Well Rehabilitation</u> – Pump Tech pulled the pump on Monday (4/6/15). The findings were as follows: (1) pump heavily biofouled; (2) well screens plugged up; (3) casing pipe feeding raw water severely corroded along with the motor; (4) impellers damaged; and (5) the pump does appear not salvageable. Discussion ensued.

The District's consultant, Robinson Noble, submitted a proposal to prepare the contract documents for rehabilitating the well. Reference Item 5.3, Resolution <u>15-4-13C</u>.
