WHEREAS, on June 21, 2016 and July 3, 2016, Highline Water District experienced water main ruptures on the 4" AC pipe along 2nd Ave S between S 202nd St and S 204th St causing damage to private property and the existing right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the AC main was installed as part of the Brandon Developer Extension in 1956 (Exhibit A attached and incorporated herein); and


WHEREAS, the main is at the end of its useful life and must be replaced to prevent future damage to the City right-of-way and adjacent properties

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Highline Water District, King County, Washington, as follows:

Pursuant to RCW 39.04.280(1)(e); (2)(b) and (3), the Board of Commissioners authorizes the actions of the General Manager to declare the water main failure along 2nd Ave S between S 202nd St and S 204th St an emergency and to retain a contractor to perform the emergency replacement work on a time and materials basis.
