<u>6/22/16 Main Break at 23616 16th Ave S</u> – Last Wednesday, a main break occurred on 16th Ave S just north of S 240th St. District crews made the repairs on the 10" AC main. Due to pressure loss a boil water advisory was issued to affected residents. The water quality samples were satisfactory and the boil water advisory was lifted on Friday (6/24/16).

Jeremy informed the Board there have been several breaks on this 10" AC main since 2000 and recommended to the Board to start the design process to replace the existing main.
