6.1 <u>SPU Request for Equipment Installation</u> - Doug King, Department of Information Technology, City of Seattle, contacted Jeremy in regards to installing antennas on the District's McMicken Heights tank. The District's current policy is \$9,600 per year for cell sites. The City requested a reduction in the fee. Discussion ensued. The Board was opposed to making an exception to the District's policy. The Board would like to discuss in the future raising the fee and the possibility for two rate structures, one for private and one for government.
