6. STAFF/COMMISSIONERS/ATTORNEY Jeremy DelMar

6.1 City of SeaTac Overlay (12th Pl S and 13th Ave S between S 200th St & S 207th St) — The City of SeaTac plans to overlay the road this summer. The District has approximately 4,500 LF of undersized AC water main in the City's project area. Jeremy recommended to the Board that by partnering with the City on this project, the District would save on overlay costs. Jeremy will present for the Board's consideration at the 3/15/17 Board meeting a resolution for a design contract with Murray, Smith & Associates, Inc. for a water main replacement. At Commissioner Quong-Vermeire's request, Jeremy will provide the Board with information on the process of prioritizing capital improvement projects.
