5. RESOLUTIONS/MOTIONS

7. PRELIMINARY 2018 BUDGET DISCUSSION

The General Manager and District Engineer discussed the need to add two positions to the District's workforce (engineer and utility worker). The positions will be included in the 2018 Budget for the Boards' consideration.

The City of Seattle plans to increase water rates approximately 5.3% in 2018. The District's water rates will need to be increased by about 2.6% in 2018.

- 8.1 <u>Sprint Spectrum LP Site Lease at North Hill</u> A final site lease agreement has been reached by the District and Sprint Spectrum LP. A public hearing will be held at the 10/18/17 Board meeting.
- 8.2 <u>Crestview Reservoir Overflow</u> On 9/21/17 at approximately 12:00 a.m., the reservoir overflowed and the water went into the City of Tukwila's storm system, however, the storm system could not handle the volume of water and the overflow caused damage to a nearby construction site. District staff is working to determine the cause of the overflow and extent of damages.
