WHEREAS, Grantee desires to relinquish said right of entry for utility vault access; and

WHEREAS, Grantee has received a signed and executed replacement agreement from the City of SeaTac, (the legal owner of the property). Said agreement has been recorded with King County under recording no. 20180212001327.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. For valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Highline Water District (formerly King County Water District No. 75) (Grantee) hereby relinquishes, vacates, and quit claims all interest in said agreement No. 20110819000328 for water utility vault.
- 2. The General Manager or designee is authorized to execute the Release of Right of Entry No. 20110819000328 (Attachment-2) as described and incorporated herein.
