- The Board Commissioners of Highline Water District does hereby authorize the Auditing Officer(s) <u>Matt Everett</u>, <u>Debbie Prior and Jeremy DelMar</u>, to submit warrants and claims for payment and disbursement in accordance with <u>HWDC</u>, <u>Title 2 – Officers and Administration</u>, <u>Chapter 2.16 Purchasing</u>, prior to the Board taking action to approve said claims.
