## 5. **RESOLUTIONS/MOTIONS**

Resolution <u>17-9-6A</u> authorizing contract with PumpTech, Inc. for Well Pump Repairs at McMicken Heights. Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

- 6.1 9/3/17 Main Break @ S 176th St (4400 Block) District crews responded to a 6" AC main break early Sunday morning. One homeowner's crawl space was flooded and there was damage to the asphalt road. The crew had to work around electrical conduits that were located above the main. The repairs took approximately 15 hours to complete. Staff will research and provide a recommendation to the Board whether to add this site to the 2017 AC Water System Improvements project as a change order.
- 6.2 <u>District Property @ 17461 Ambaum Blvd S</u> Proper "No Trespassing" signs are posted. Fencing will be installed where trespassers accessed the property.

- 6.4 <u>IRS Provides Special Relief to Encourage Leave-Based Donation Programs for Victims of Hurricane Harvey</u> Matt informed the Board of this donation program as follows:

Under these programs, employees may forgo their vacation, sick or personal leave in exchange for cash payments the employer makes, before Jan. 1, 2019, to charitable organizations providing relief for the victims of this disaster.

Under this special relief, the donated leave will not be included in the income or wages of the employees. Employers will be permitted to deduct the cash payments as business expenses.

A motion to authorize the District to participate in this donation program or one similar to it will be presented at the 9/20/17 Board meeting.
