7.1 <u>Project 16-3 Mansion Hill Reservoir Relocation</u> — A resolution to authorize construction management contract with Gray & Osborne will be presented at the 11/7/18 meeting for the Board's consideration.

- 7.2 <u>Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA)</u> Matt asked the Board to consider giving all employees a 3.5% COLA (effective 1/1/19). Action Taken: Reference Motion <u>18-10-23(1)</u>
- 7.3 <u>HWD Staffing and Succession Planning</u> Matt discussed planned retirements and future staffing requirements for next year to include adding three positions: (1) Meter Technician; (2) Administrative; (3) Utility Worker. The District needs to be proactive in order to provide proper training in advance of retirements. Matt also recommended the District create an Acting Supervisor position in Accounting. The Commissioners were in favor of the recommendations by the General Manager.
- 7.4 <u>Federal Way Excise Tax Lawsuit</u> Oral arguments were heard on 10/19/18 in Superior Court at the Kent Regional Justice Center. The judge will render his decision on 10/29/18.
