6. COMMISSIONERS/STAFF/ATTORNEY Jeremy DelMar

- 6.1 <u>GIS Update</u> A resolution to purchase upgrade of the District's existing GIS software from ESRI (sole source) will be presented to the Board for their consideration at the 1/22/19 Board Workshop. Logan Wallace, Sr. Project Engineer, will give a presentation at the meeting.
- 6.2 <u>City of SeaTac 34th Ave S Sidewalk Project (S 160th to S 166th)</u> The City of SeaTac now wants the District to partner on their street improvements project in lieu of the District replacing water main before the street improvements. The City plans to delay the project until 2020. The District will have the design for the water main replacement completed this year. The City plans to bid the project in November 2019 with construction in early 2020.
- 6.3 <u>Project 19-1 AC Water Main Replacement (North Hill area)</u> The City of Des Moines would like to partner with the District to include street improvements. Discussion ensued. The District is working on consultant selection for the water main design.
- 6.4 <u>Project 18-2 International Blvd & SR 509 Road Improvements</u> The District will need to install temporary bypass water main in advance of the bridge work by WSDOT. The deadline for the District to move its infrastructure is June 2020. Upon completion of the bridge, the District's water main will be affixed to the bridge.
- 6.5 <u>Project 16-2 Pump Station No. 8</u> The District has made an offer to the owner for an easement. The District has yet to receive a response from the owner on the District's proposal. The District is now considering alternative alignments. Additional design will be required to reconfigure the main location to eliminate the need for an easement.

- 6.6 <u>Code of Ethics</u> The Board received a copy of the Commissioners' Code of Ethics for their annual review.
- 6.7 <u>Accounting Position</u> The top six candidates were interviewed. The three finalists will be interviewed next week.

- 6.8 <u>Burien Franchise Meeting (1/10/19)</u> Highline, and representatives of K.C.W.D. 20, K.C.W.D. 49, Midway Sewer District, Southwest Suburban Sewer District, and Valley View Sewer District attended a meeting with the City's Manager, Public Works Manager, Finance Manager, and Attorney to open negotiations for a water or sewer franchise agreement with the respective Districts. Highline was represented by Matt Everett, Jeremy DelMar and attorney Eric Frimodt with Inslee Best. The City of Burien wants franchises completed by the 3rd quarter of 2019.
- 6.9 <u>Government Relations Committee Meeting Update (1/10/19)</u> Matt attended the meeting. Items discussed: (1) State Legislators were not inclined to move forward to reduce lien fees; (2) reclaimed water; and (3) allowing smaller water and sewer districts to offer their commissioners medical insurance.
