## 5. **RESOLUTIONS/MOTIONS**

Resolution <u>19-6-19B</u> authorizing the purchase of a temporary construction easement and a permanent utility easement with Piramco Sea-Tac, Inc. relating to Project 18-2 International Blvd at SR509 Road Improvements. Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

Resolution 19-6-19C declaring an emergency pursuant to RCW 39.04.280(1)(e), waiving the competitive bidding requirements of RCW 57.08.050, and authorizing and directing the district manager or designee to negotiate, approve, and execute the necessary contracts on the district's behalf to perform emergency relocation and replacement work along International Blvd South and SR509 in the City of SeaTac. Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

Resolution <u>19-6-19D</u> commending employee (Debbie Prior) for twenty-five years of service with the District. Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.
