RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER NO. 2 TO HWD CONTRACT #19-70-32 WITH T. BAILEY, INC. FOR PROJECT 16-3 MANSION HILL RESERVOIR RELOCATION FOR THE REMEDIATION OF CONTAMINATED SOILS AT THE MANSION HILL TANK SITE

WHEREAS, the District was made aware by Sound Transit on 3/19/19 of contaminated soils were present at the Mansion Hill Reservoir site; and

WHEREAS, the District retained the services of Shannon & Wilson to perform an independent investigation to validate Sound Transit's conclusions; and

WHEREAS, Shannon and Wilson confirmed the presence of lead and arsenic in excess of environmental regulations and developed a Site Remediation Plan to address the contaminated soils; and

WHEREAS, the District executed a Voluntary Cleanup Program Agreement with the Washington State Dept. of Ecology to facilitate independent remedial action at the Mansion Hill Reservoir site; and

WHEREAS, the District facilitated negotiations for a change order with T. Bailey Inc., the general contractor performing the construction of the new tank as part of Project 16-3 Mansion Hill Reservoir Relocation, to perform the remediation work in accordance with the Site Remediation Plan; and

WHEREAS, T. Bailey Inc., presented a proposal to load, haul and lawful disposal of the contaminated soils and to restore the disturbed area as described in the Site Remediation Plan totaling \$399,772.85 plus sales tax.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the General Manager to prepare, negotiate and execute a change order with T Bailey, Inc for a not-to-exceed amount of \$399,772.85 (not including sales tax) to perform the site remediation of contaminated soils.
- 2. The General Manager or Designee is authorized to prepare the necessary paperwork and to grant an appropriate time extension of the contract duration to perform the remediation work.
