WHEREAS, the cost to upgrade the SQL Server operating system and migration is \$65,400.00; and

WHEREAS, District staff reviewed and are satisfied with the Statement of Work from NorthStar and recommend approval to proceed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the General Manager or designee to enter into an agreement with NorthStar for server upgrade and migration for a not-to-exceed amount of \$65,400.00.
- 2. The General Manager and/or the District's legal counsel are authorized to make minor changes to the agreement if required.
