6.1 <u>Long Term Care Act</u> – Effective January 1, 2022, all W-2 employees will be subject to this new payroll tax (0.58% of gross). There are provisions to opt out. WASWD is working with Gallagher, which administers the District's VEBA, on the long-term care benefits for special purpose districts.

6.2 <u>King County Parks Mid Lake to Sound Trail</u> – The City of Burien and King County entered an interlocal agreement. The District's 16" water main conflicts with the project and will need to be relocated. King County has offered to partner with the District. King County has contracted with Parametrix for the design. Jeremy will request a proposal from Parametrix to design the water main replacement.

6.3 <u>Huntington Park Water Main Replacement</u> — Representatives from Huntington Park informed Jeremy that they are planning to repave the roads in the development in the near future and will delay the project if District desires to replace the existing AC main and PVC pipe. The main replacement would be included in the 2022 Budget for 2023 construction. A resolution to authorize a consultant contract for the design will be presented at a future Board meeting.

6.4 <u>HWD-Tukwila Intertie</u> – Matt informed the Board that a second amendment to the Tolling Agreement will allow additional time for the parties to engage in discussions and related efforts to explore whether there are reasonable opportunities to resolve dispute relating to District water conveyed to the City through the intertie, the cost of which remains unpaid. The Board agreed for Matt to sign the second amendment which will expire 12/31/21.
