- 6.3 Project 18-5 34th Ave S Water Main Replacement Jeremy informed the Board that a resolution will be presented at the 7/27/21 Workshop to authorize an interlocal agreement with the City of SeaTac. The District will be replacing approximately 2,000 LF of water main between S 160th St & S 166th St.
- 6.4 <u>Sr. Citizens Disabled and/or Low-Income Customers Monthly Meter Base Rate Discount</u> The District currently has a discount for Sr. Citizens Disabled and/or Low-Income customers that are served by 5/8" and 3/4" meters.
