5. RESOLUTIONS/MOTIONS

Motion <u>21-10-20(1)</u> duly made and seconded denying a leak adjustment to F.R. McAbee for water usage caused by alleged tampering of their irrigation system and not a leak to their water service line. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously. Reference Item 6.4.

- 6.1 <u>3rd Quarter Financial Report</u> The report will be emailed to the Commissioners on Friday and will be discussed at the 10/26/21 Board Workshop.
- 6.2 Local 32 Collective Bargaining Agreement 2020-2023 Anne and Matt discussed keeping the current medical plan insurance co-pays the same in 2022 as they were in 2021. After discussion, the Board was in favor of continuing the current medical and dental insurance plan co-pay (Article 12, Section 12.1 Medical and Dental Insurance) in 2022. Staff will present a motion at the 10/26/21 Board Workshop for authorization to continue with the current medical and dental insurance co-pay methodology in 2022.

- 6.4 <u>Irrigation Leak Adjustment Request</u> The District received an email (10/12/21) from Brandon Schaeffer, Facility Manager, with F.R. McAbee, Inc requesting a leak adjustment due to vandals breaking into the irrigation control box and turning on the water multiple times without their knowledge. The District's leak credit policy only covers a leak to their water service line. Discussion ensued.

 Action Taken: Reference Item 5 Motion 21-10-20(1).
- 6.5 <u>Letters/Callouts to Delinquent Customer Accounts</u> The District sent approximately 500 letters to customers with accounts in arrears. To date the District has made 65 payment arrangements with customers and 30 customers have paid the balance of their account. Matt said water service shutoffs will start in January 2022 if payment arrangements have not been made as agreed, or if customer with delinquent account makes no effort to enter into payment arrangements or pay water bill.
