## 3A. PUBLIC HEARING - PROPOSED 2022 RATES

President Fultz opened the Public Hearing at 9:03 am. The General Manager gave a Power Point Presentation on the proposed 2022 rate changes. The General Manager and administrative staff recommended a 3.5% rate increase to account for inflation (approximately 6% in 2021) and considerable Capital Improvement projects. The proposed rate changes are as follows: Water Commodity Charges – Increase 3.5%; Meter Base Rates – Increase 3.5%; Low Income, Sr. or Disabled – Decrease Meter Base Rate from 35% to 50%. President Fultz requested comments from the public. No members of the public attended the public hearing in person or remotely. After discussion, President Fultz closed the public hearing at 9:09 am. No action taken. A resolution to adopt the proposed rates will be presented at the 12/01/21 Board Meeting.

## 6. 2022 DRAFT GOALS & OBJECTIVES DISCUSSION

Management discussed the following key items of the 2022 draft Goals & Objectives:

<u>Water Quality</u>: Flush all distribution main lines every six years (50 miles annually) <u>Treatment Plant Operations</u>: Revise and update Operations and Maintenance Manuals

<u>Customer Service</u>: Eliminated comment cards and work with customers in-person, via email and phone.

Finance/Administration: Update guidelines for purchasing and contracting.

Staff Development and Training: Facilitate succession planning and transition.

Records Management: Develop network drive retention guidelines and continue staff training on records retention.

Departmental Meetings: Resume committee meetings suspended during COVID pandemic.

Discussion ensued. No action taken. A resolution will be presented to the Board to adopt the 2022 Goals & Objectives at the 12/15/21 Board meeting.
