## About Highline Water District

*Our mission is to provide high quality water and excellent customer service while effectively managing District infrastructure for a reliable water system today and for future generations.*

*Highline Water District is a strong and successful utility with a focus on meeting the needs of our customers and maintaining strong city partnerships.*

Highline Water District was incorporated in 1946. We currently serve 78,000 people living and working in South King County—including portions of the cities of Burien, Des Moines, Federal Way, Kent, Normandy Park, SeaTac, and Tukwila, as well as areas in unincorporated King County—encompassing roughly 18 square miles and 18,900 water meters. Sixty-five percent of our water is supplied by Seattle Public Utilities, with the remaining portion produced from four District-owned groundwater wells with three treatment facilities. The District has 32 employees and an elected 5-member Board of Commissioners with a 2023 operating budget of \$21 million dollars and includes approximately \$7.7 million in annual capital improvements.

## The Position

Seasonal Maintenance Worker (Temporary)  
in the Operations Department

*Highline Water District (HWD) is currently seeking two (2) Temporary Seasonal Maintenance Workers to join our team. As a Maintenance Worker, you will be assigned to the Operations Department and report to the Operations and Field Supervisors. This is a temporary position and will last no more than 100 calendar days between June and September.*

### Essential Duties and Responsibilities

As a successful candidate, you will be responsible for performing maintenance on fire hydrants, painting, office maintenance, grounds maintenance, vehicle maintenance, courier duties, and other duties as assigned. This position is considered an entry-level position, and an ideal candidate will have knowledge or experience in cleaning, operating grounds equipment (weed eater, pressure washer, etc.), working outdoors, and experience using hand and power tools.

### Requirements

Applicants must be 18 years of age or older, possess a Valid Washington State Driver's License, have a high school diploma or GED. See Job Description for a listing of duties and requirements.
