- 6.1 North Hill Tank: Operations Manager Hite informed the Board that Sprint is removing their equipment from the tank. Vent replacement will commence next week.
- 6.2 <u>21-3 Mansion Hill 2.5 MG Reservoir</u>: Hite informed the Board that Evergreen Coating designed this project to paint and upgrade the reservoir. The advertisement for bid will go out next week and be awarded on August 22nd. The anticipated completion is approximately 10 months.

- 6.2 <u>21-1 Des Moines 24th Ave S Water Main Replacement</u>: General manager DelMar informed the Board that bidding is complete, and the apparent low bidder was SCI Infrastructure.
- 6.3 <u>22-1 King County Lake to Trail Water Main Relocation</u>: DelMar informed the Board that bidding is complete and the County plans to award to the fourth lowest bidder, Road Construction NW.
- 6.4 Out of the Office: DelMar informed the Board that he will be out of the office July 21-25. He will not be attending the Board Workshop on 7/25.
- 6.4 King County Water District 54 (KCWD 54): DelMar updated the Board on the status of KCWD 54 and his discussion with Department of Health. It appears KCWD 54 has three options moving forward, two of which will affect HWD. DelMar requested that, if they want to merge with HWD or purchase water from HWD, KCWD 54 submit a letter of intention by the end of the month so he can proceed with negotiations with the City of Seattle. DelMar will prepare a document for the Board(s) outlining the pros and cons of the options affecting HWD.

DelMar discussed establishing a wholesale water rate for KCWD54 per the prior direction by the Board. DelMar will prepare a resolution for a wholesale rate of 20% M/O Admin plus the wholesale rate charged by SPU to present at an upcoming meeting.

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There being no further business, President Johnson concluded the meeting at 9:48 a.m.
