Resolution <u>16-7-20B</u> authorizing developer extension agreement (The Pinnacles at Des Moines). Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

Resolution <u>16-7-20C</u> authorizing developer extension agreement (Westview). Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

Resolution <u>16-7-20D</u> commending employee Dan Sleeth for thirty years of service with the District. Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

Motion <u>16-7-20(1)</u> duly made and seconded authorizing WASWD Section IV to include Highline Water District in letter to King County Council Transportation, Economy, & Environment Committee that the proposed revisions to policies PF-3 and 1.F 102 in the King County Comprehensive Plan Update be deleted or modified to be consistent with the expressed language in the Growth Management Act. - 6.2 <u>2nd Ave S Emergency Water Main Replacement</u> Miles Resources completed the main replacement on 2nd Ave S between S 202nd St & S 204th St. The road will be paved in August.
- 6.3 <u>Tyee Well Redevelopment</u> Pump Tech installed the new pump and motor on 7/18/16. Upon completion of electrical work, District staff will purge the aquifer and perform test sampling of the water.
- 6.4 <u>Project 14-3 Manhattan View Water Main Replacement</u> A final walk-through of the project with the City of Normandy Park is scheduled today at 11:30 a.m.
- 6.5 <u>Project 13-1A Angle Lake Water Main Replacement</u> The project is expected to be completed by the end of this week.
