The District's Board directed Everett to contact Ken Kase, General Manager, Midway Sewer District and Ron Speer, General Manager, Soos Creek Water & Sewer District, to see if they were interested in partnering with Highline in hiring Joe Daniels to represent their Districts in the 2018 Legislative Session.
