6.1 <u>Sound Transit FW Link Extension</u> – Kiewit will begin the grading and drilling work the first week of February at the District's headquarters parking lot. There will be six weeks of drilling for columns and Kiewit will return in few months to build the columns.



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6. COMMISSIONERS/STAFF/ATTORNEY Jeremy DelMar

- 6.2 <u>City of Federal Way Franchise</u> Jeremy received a phone call from the City of Federal Way inquiring about the status of a franchise agreement. The District has never had a franchise agreement with the City. The City is now requiring a franchise agreement with the District for facilities in the right-of-way and will not review or authorize permits without a franchise agreement. Jeremy will send a letter to the Public Works Director requesting a copy of the City's draft franchise for the District to review.
- 6.3 <u>Tukwila/HWD Intertie</u> Commissioner Koester inquired the status of the intertie. Jeremy informed the Board that the City is supportive of the concept for the District taking water from Tukwila through an intertie to serve the pressure zone to Veteran's Drive. The District is exploring options to install a jockey pump in the intertie to pump 40-60 g.p.m. continuously. Discussion ensued. No action taken.

- 6.5 <u>City of Burien Utility Tax</u> The City's Utility tax became effective 01/01/2021 with the District's first payment due two months later. The tax is on gross revenues providing water/sewer service. The District has multiple streams of revenue. Discussions are ongoing to determine which revenue streams apply to the City's tax.
- 6.6 <u>2020 Year-End Numbers</u> Water sales were down less than 1%; unaccounted for water loss was at 9%.
