### 5. RESOLUTIONS/MOTIONS

Resolution <u>21-7-7A</u> to authorize Consultant Agreement #21-60-18 with Parametrix, Inc. for Project SW21-1 Des Moines Memorial Drive Water Main Realignment. Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

Resolution <u>21-7-78</u> to authorize Small Site Asphalt and Concrete Patching Repair Work Contract #21-50-16 with Asphalt Patch Systems, Inc. Motion duly made and seconded. After discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

- 6.1 <u>HWD Headquarters Security Glass Barrier System</u> Matt informed the Board that the cost for the purchase and installation is under \$25,000. The contract with Total Security Systems is 100 calendar days.
- 6.2 <u>Update District COVID-19 Policy</u> Matt requested a motion from the Board to adopt the updated Washington State Department of Labor and Industries Requirements and Guidelines for employers relating to vaccinated and unvaccinated employees, verifying worker vaccination status and masks and face coverings (reference L&I Publication F414-164-000 [06-2021]. Discussion ensued. Action Taken: See Item 5, Motion 21-7-7(1).
- 6.3 <u>Chlorine Supply Shortage</u> Per Seattle Public Utilities the chlorine shortage has been resolved.
- 6.4 <u>Customer Shutoffs and Late Charges</u> Governor Inslee issued a final extension prohibiting shutoffs of water service and assessing late charges through 9/30/21.
- 6.5 <u>City of SeaTac Draft Franchise</u> Will Appleton, Public Works Director, sent a draft franchise agreement for the District's review. Matt will update the Board on negotiations at a future Board meeting. Matt said that Highline will likely work with the other water districts with customers in SeaTac to complete the final draft of this Franchise Agreement with the City.
