6.1 <u>1st Pl SW & S 200th St Water Main Replacement</u> – District crews completed the project in conjunction with the City of Normandy Park's overlay program.

<u>S 200th & 2nd Ave S Water Main Replacement</u> – District crews have installed the main and are taking water samples.

<u>Woodmont Drive & S 263rd Water Main Replacement</u> – District crews will begin the main replacement the first week of May in conjunction with the Des Moines overlay program.

- 6.3 <u>Senior Accounting Specialist Position</u> Four applicants will be interviewed next week.

- 6.4 Westwater Construction vs. US Labor & Industries Pipefitters/Plumbers Prevailing Wage Pay Westwater Construction appealed a decision that they should have to pay pipefitters the same pay as plumbers. WASWD is participating in the appeal and has requested water districts to assist with the appeal by contributing to the legal costs. The decision by L & I will significantly impact the costs of future capital improvement projects. Action Taken: See Item 5, Motion 22-4-20(1).
- 6.5 <u>GPS Unit Stolen</u> A field worker discovered the GPS Unit was stolen when on a job site. The District has submitted a claim for the loss and will be purchasing a replacement. The Board should expect to see a charge for the cost of a new unit while staff works out a claim for the replacement unit.
- 6.6 <u>Radio Club Antenna</u> Commissioner Quong-Vermeire asked for an update. Jeremy said he is working with the attorney on provisions for terms and will be drafting an agreement.
