

Requested locks for irrigation meters will not be charged a monthly base rate. Motion 11-4-20(1) authorized allowing an exception of the monthly meter base rate if a catastrophic event occurs that renders a property uninhabitable such as a fire.*

**COMMENTS:**

The District advertised and held a public hearing at the 12/7/22 Board Workshop for the purpose of accepting public testimony on adjustment of and possible increase to customer water rates, service fees and charges.
